Git Create and Clone

There are two ways to create a new online repository in GitHub¹):

- Create online and clone to PC
- Create on PC and push to git

The first approach is simpler as it requires less work and commands to accomplish a working repository.

Create online and clone

- Create a new²⁾ repository on GitHub
 - Add a readme
 - Add a license
 - \circ Add a gitignore
- Click the green "Clone or Download" button and copy the new Git URL.
- Open a command prompt on the PC with the git installed and in the path
- Change to the directory where the repository should be cloned into
- Issue the git command 'git clone "<URL>" where <URL> is the link copied in the step above.

Create on PC and push
